A focal point of the foundation is to bring insightful, engaging, and exciting programs to the at-risk youth population and targets their lack of exposure with specific literacy.

The PMJ Foundation's Career Awareness Project (CAP) is a unique after-school program that brings the outside professional world to funded Baltimore City and County schools. In 2006, the CAP program curriculum was developed and implemented in schools specifically targeting at-risk youth. Resources are utilized to help engage participants, educate and foster long-term goals. CAP participants evaluate and assess their interests, create a personal portfolio, professional volunteers are invited to sessions who share their career, and the education necessary to obtain a particular position. Field trips and other tangible resources are given so students are able to correlate educational success to higher education and a career. Professional volunteers are vital to the program.

Since launching the program, CAP has seen a dramatic increase of academic performance and attendance, as well as a decrease in school drop-out rates. This is attributed to the exposure afforded to at-risk youth through CAP and its' community volunteers. What was once a limited vision of our participants' future has now become infinite and attainable. We have proudly served nearly a thousand students in fifth grade and middle school. With your support, CAP will continue mentoring and providing opportunities as well as expand our efforts to include high school students.

Sponsored schools offer the CAP program to students beginning at the end of September with another session available in the spring. It is exciting to present this invaluable service to community children with the help of sponsors and volunteers. We always extend an invitation for professionals to attend a program, give insight of their career, and guide our youth. When more students are exposed to potential career paths, the more we are able to "present possibilities for brighter futures." 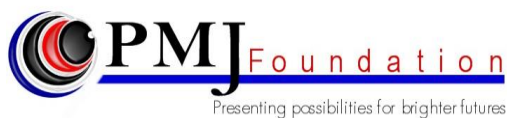
